

FLINT METRO LEAGUE COMPETITIVE CHEER
BY-LAWS

Effective 1 November 2019

1. Flint Metro League competition (MHSAA sanctioned) will be held when at least half of the league schools sponsor competitive cheer.

2. Three varsity competitions will take place at three different host schools. A Flint Metro League trophy will be awarded to the first place team. The League Champion will be determined by adding together placement points totals awarded at the three league sponsored events, with the placement points for the third competition doubled.

a. In the event there is a tie in the first two meets, points will be shared (e.g. If two teams tie for 6th place, both teams will receive 6.5 points and 7th place points will not be awarded.).

3. Round draws for all three league competitions will occur at the Flint Metro League coaches meeting during the fall season or in the beginning of the sideline/fall season at a cheer coaches' meeting to which all varsity Competitive Cheer Coaches will be invited. Results will be given to coaches at that time.

4. All-League Honors will be given according to the number of teams sponsoring Competitive Cheer, as follows:

All League selections will be turned in to the athletic director in charge of Competitive Cheer within one week of the third competition and will be posted on the FML website at that time.

5. At the annual preseason coaches meeting, when round orders are determined, the league will ensure that no school will perform FIRST or LAST more than ONCE during all league competitions during a given season.
