With the addition of Swartz Creek in 2006-07, the Metro once again became a nine-team league. For the next two seasons, Metro schools played each other once during the regular season before playing a seeded three-day tournament at the end of the season. The ninth place school from the regular season did not participate in the tournament so

that no byes were required (that team played non-league matches on the three tournament dates).

The 2006-07 season was the last season that volleyball was played as a winter sport in Michigan. Beginning in 2007-08, volleyball was played as a fall sport.

With the addition of Kearsley giving the Flint Metro League ten schools, in 2008-09 the league returned to using dual match records (single round-robin schedule) and the team's finish in a one-day post-season tournament to determine the final standings.
